We are looking for people to participate in a scientific study who are

- of age and
- able to work remotely.

We are researching what effects different indoor climates have on the human body.

For this purpose, we are looking for participants to work in a shared office environment for a full workday (08:30 am – 4:30 pm), which we thermally condition throughout the day. At the same time, non-invasive physiological signals, such as sweat activity, heart rate variability, core body temperature and changes in skin temperature are measured.

The evaluation of this study will help to redefine legal regulations for the necessary air conditioning of indoor spaces in order to take less energy-intensive measures. Therefore, the aim is not to create extreme thermal conditions, but simply to recreate realistic temperatures and air movement.

We specifically encourage the participation of all people and are happy to arrange for and discuss individual diversity-sensitive protocols.
