Design Concept

The envisaged public open space on the northern end of the Fuxing Island aims to provide an ideal platform of inspiration, communication for people who work in the Fuxing Island Innovation District and its surroundings. Meanwhile, it is also a park for recreation and all kinds of activities for the residents. The idea of Structuralism in landscape architecture contributes to organizing the whole area with a stable framework, which is derived from the extracted information layers of the site. On the one hand, this communicative and comprehensible framework enables people to trace the past glory of the fishing industry through its various spatial characteristics and preserved and renovated industrial relics. On the other hand, it aims to stimulate the visitors' interpretations of the site through a new invented historical ground. The individual elements of the park are open for change and adjustment in the future, while the whole set of relationships remains stable and recognizable.
